WHAT ARE THE TITLES OF THE PARTIES IN THE LAWSUITS?

The person who begins a lawsuit is called the “Plaintiff”. The person who is sued is called the “Defendant”. Each side can be more than one plaintiff or defendant in a lawsuit and there can be a common person or a juristic person or a government agency.

WHAT IS OUT-OF-COURT SETTLEMENT?

Generally, the **Civil Lawsuit** involves a dispute between individual parties; therefore, it can be settled by the parties at any time. If the parties agree to end the lawsuit on terms that they both find acceptable. Such “Out-of-Court settlement shall be enforced between the parties, but it also be the considerable risks or need litigation later on.

WHY DO YOU NEED AN ATTORNEY INVOLVED?

Depending on the seriousness of your disputes or claims. Many disputes are settled before any party files a lawsuit. If it is small claim, you may able to work out a settlement with your opponent without hiring an attorney. Similarly, if your dispute is one that you can handle and can petition a claim to the local Court, you may not need an attorney, but the process of filing the case is very important, since preparing all involved evidence, content in a pleading though your plan or good strategy to win your opponent in Court.

For larger claims, you need an expertise attorney to represent your interests either working out a settlement of the dispute before a lawsuit is started or being your representative in court. The Rules of Civil Procedure that govern court proceedings are very complicates and very strictly, the lawsuit specially needs to follow such court procedures, if you did not perform well, the result of your case can be lost in any procedure or possibly stand at a distinct disadvantage if you do not have an attorney.
